Dementia Care

The majority of our residents are people with dementia. Dementia refers to a collection of symptoms characterised by the progressive loss of cognitive abilities that affects reasoning and communication, and the ability for an individual to carry out routine activities associated with daily living.



Person Centred Care

At Camelot Care we focus on providing the best person-centred care for people with dementia and mental health problems. Our knowledge and expertise in this specific area allows us to use our experience, research and past evidence to provide a tailored, person-centred approach to the needs of those in our care.

All our homes have 'Discovery Boards' and 'Rummage Boxes' that contain memorabilia and other items to help jog our residents' memories and reminisce about their past. For each resident we create a 'Life Story Book' with photographs, clippings and memories of their personal history so far
